Pets for Life, Inc.Advocacy Award

In September, 1984, Pets for Life, Inc. was created when Bill and Harriett Snyder filed its Articles of Incorporation with the Kansas Secretary of State in Topeka. Later that fall, the Snyders started making limited visits with a handful of "volunteers." Today, Pets for Life has over 220 volunteer teams making approximately 115,000 contacts annually while visiting more than 185 facilities throughout the greater Kansas City Area.

As our organization enters its 35th year of existence, its Board of Directors felt it appropriate to create the "Pets for Life, Inc. Advocacy Award" to honor those who have displayed exemplary governance, financial support or volunteerism towards Pets for Life's mission. A plaque, showing the honorees and their induction year, is permanently and proudly displayed in the main lobby of KC Veterinary Care's, 7240 Wornall Road building, home of our headquarters since 1984.

The three inaugural inductees of the Pets for Life Advocacy Award were announced at last month's Volunteer Appreciation Pet Party. Appropriately, the first on the plaque are our founders, Bill and Harriett Snyder. Without the Snyders' vision and determination that also included funding its start-up costs, Pets for Life would not exist today. They drafted our initial by-laws and organized a governing board of directors that included their veterinarian Dan Hecker. These directors, at the mandate of Chairwoman Harriett Snyder, became Pets for Life's first volunteers, and Dan Hecker not only donated office space for the fledging

non- profit, but also "loaned-out"eligible pets from his clinic to make the initial visits....so started Pets for Life.

The second Advocacy Award was presented to Joe and Judy Roetheli. Dog lovers, the Rothelis



grew their successful Kansas City based pet treat and food company "Greenies" into the 8th largest in the industry worldwide.

As a result of their success, they created the Roetheli Lil' Red Foundation to care for the welfare, guidance and success of diverse groups, including the elderly, the needy, entrepreneurs and pets. For more than two decades, the Roethelis and their Lil' Red Foundation have been gracious donors and friends of Pets for Life. Our growth is directly attributed to their exemplary support throughout the years.

In receiving the Advocacy Award, Dr. Joe Roetheli acknowledged and thanked the Pets for Life volunteers for making Pets for Life the organization it is today..... and he's right.

The third inaugural recipient goes to another team....our Pets for Life volunteer team, Jim Schope and his Sheltie, Bobby.

We all know the story of how Jim Schope's Sheltie, Bobby, was stolen from his home. After being missing for close to a month, on a tip from a stranger, he was found in some woods close to where Jim



What you may not know, is that every month for three years, Jim and Bobby have been making close to 30 regularly scheduled facility Pets for Life visits each month. This is in addition to participating in numerous events and often acting as the distraction team for the Volunteer Team Evaluations.
